

About RENEW

Established in 2004

RENEW was founded by Her Majesty Queen Mother Sangay Choden Wangchuck in response to the needs of disadvantaged women and girls particularly survivors of domestic violence and sexual abuse

The organization promotes gender equality and advocates against any form of violence against women and children.

RENEW campaigns to prevent violence and coordinate rehabilitation services for women in need.

Vision

Violence Free Happy Society.

Mission

To better the lives of survivors of gender based violence and to reintegrate them as economically and socially productive members of society.

Objectives

- Promote gender equality and equity to prevent violence against women.
- Provide support and care services for survivors of violence in the Bhutanese society.
- Curb gender based violence and ensure a happy society.

Services

Counselling: Confidential counselling services are offered to assist families or individuals rebuild their lives.

Shelter: RENEW shelter home is a safe house which operates 24 hours. The shelter provides the survivors of family violence and their children an emergency protection. Psychological support for those survivors who requires longer duration are provided shelter protection through our Happy Home.

Legal Service: RENEW provides free legal aid to survivors of domestic violence.

Education Support: RENEW offers education support to the children affected by domestic violence. They are provided school fees with school uniforms, books, bags and other basic necessities to continue their education.

A life Renewed

Maya aged 53 and her three grandchildren aged between 3 to 10 years were referred to RENEW for shelter and psychosocial support.

She lost her daughter, Rina, who had taken her own life by jumping into the Paro river - leaving behind three wailing children. Her daughter had been traumatized and broken down by repeated violence inflicted by her abusive husband. During the same time, both Rina's father and Maya's husband in their attempt to save her were also unfortunately washed away by the river.

In one single day, Maya's world collapsed. Being poor and destitute she and her grandchildren were brought to RENEW. They were provided care and shelter by RENEW for more than a year till she got a job as a cleaner in a village headman's office.

Currently she is earning and living independently and her children are attending boarding school with support from RENEW.
